We know how we're planning to watch as NASA prepares to #LaunchAmerica – the question is, do YOU?

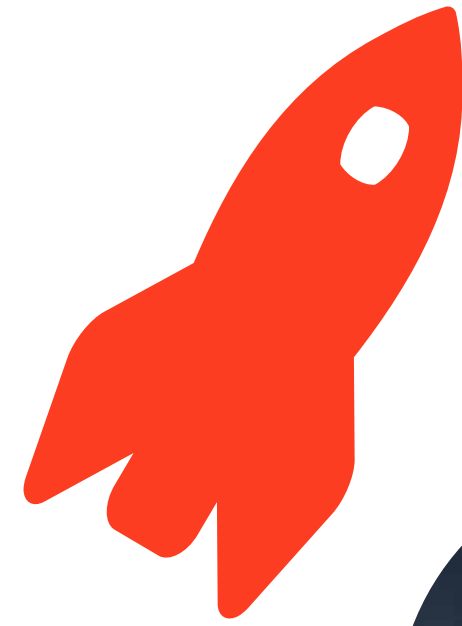

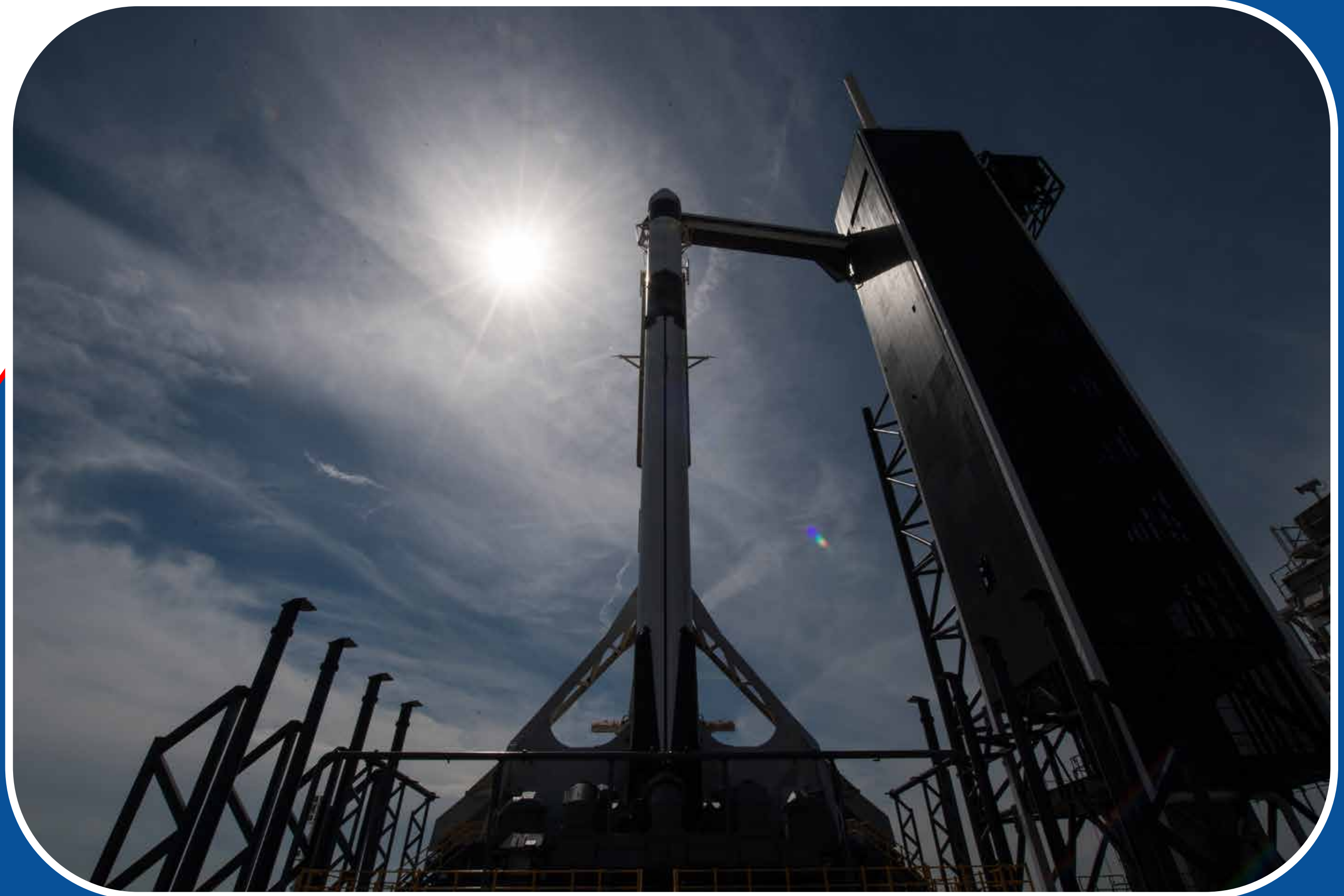

Theme Suggestions:

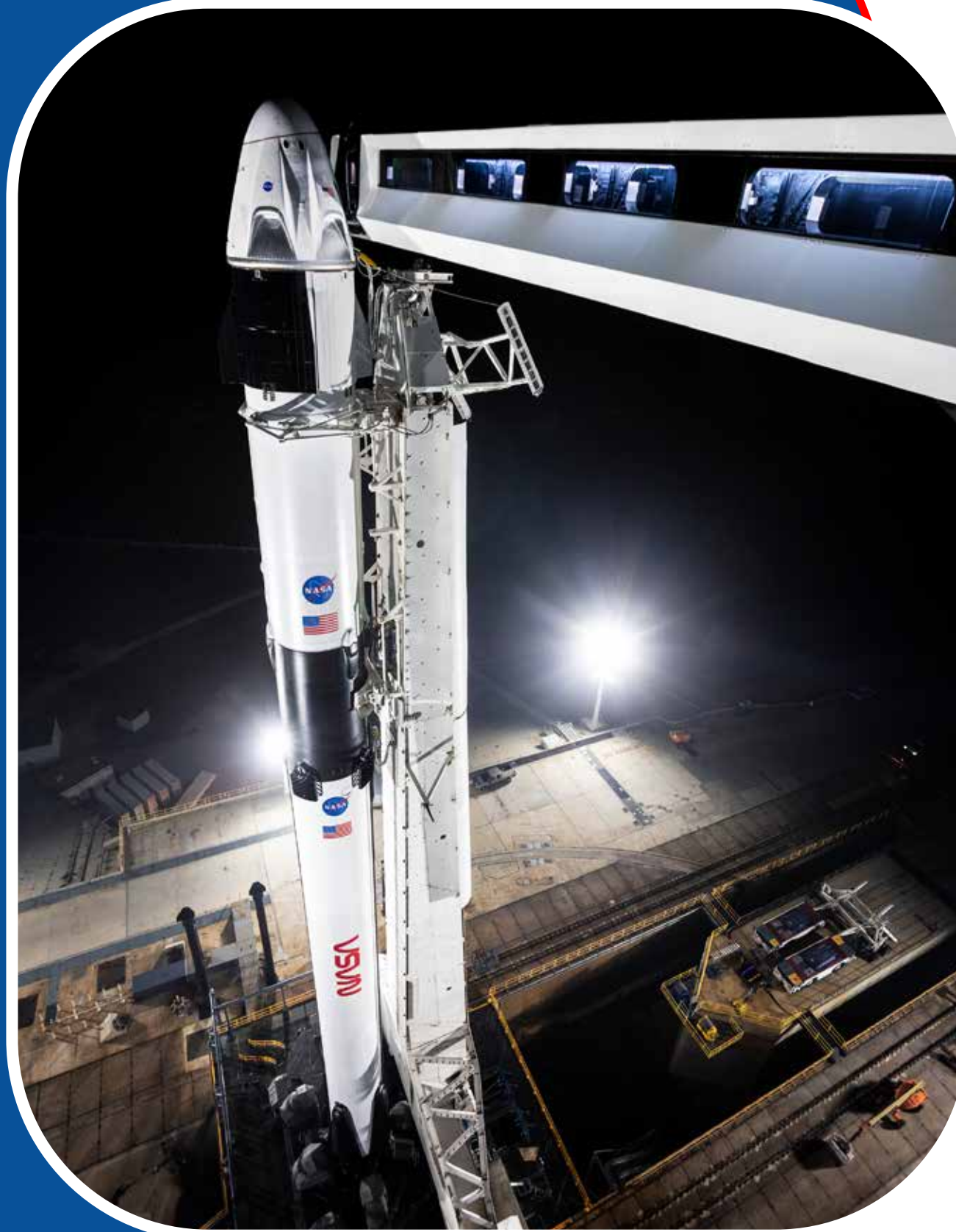
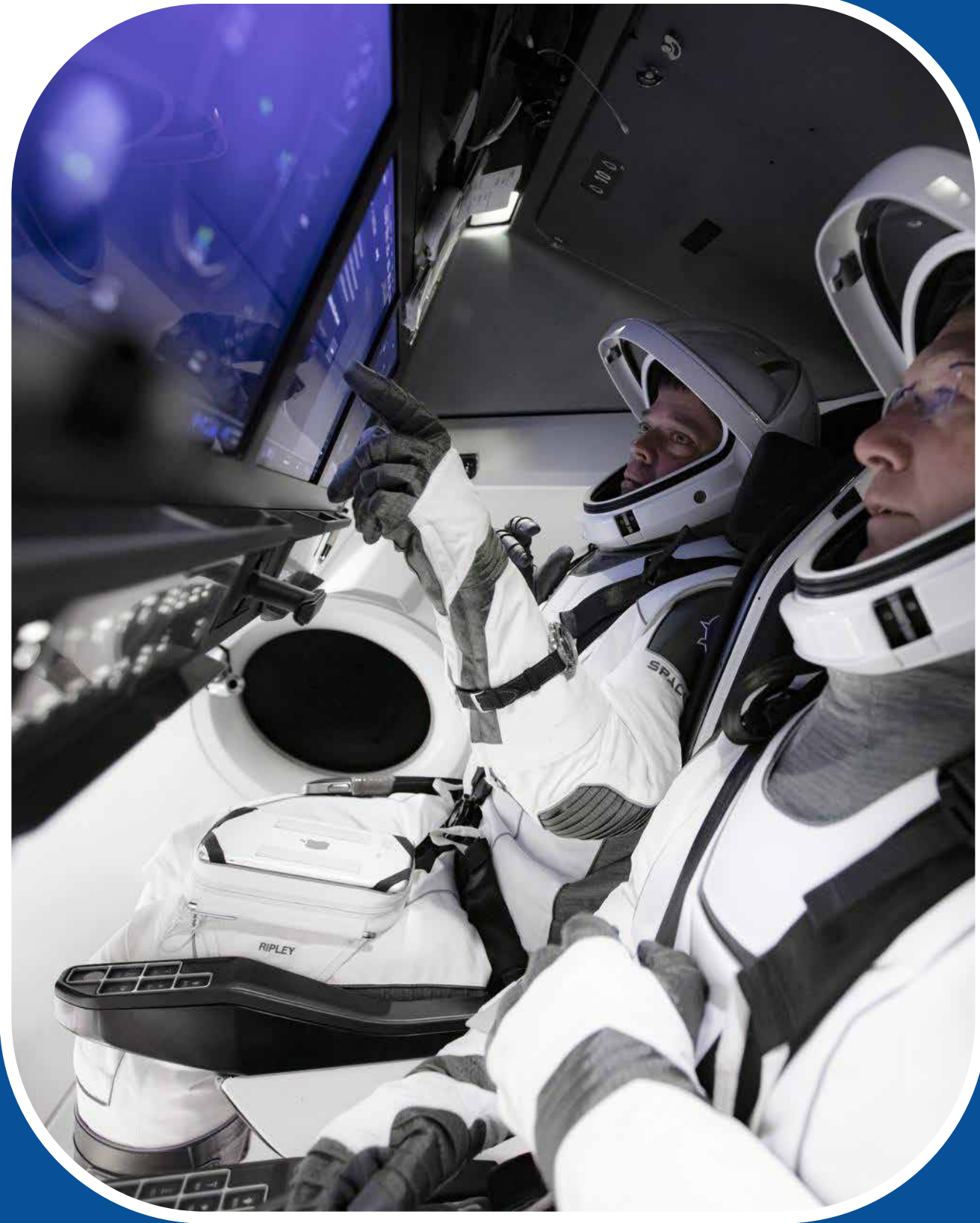
- Everyone wears their favorite NASA gear – don't forget #TheWormisBack!

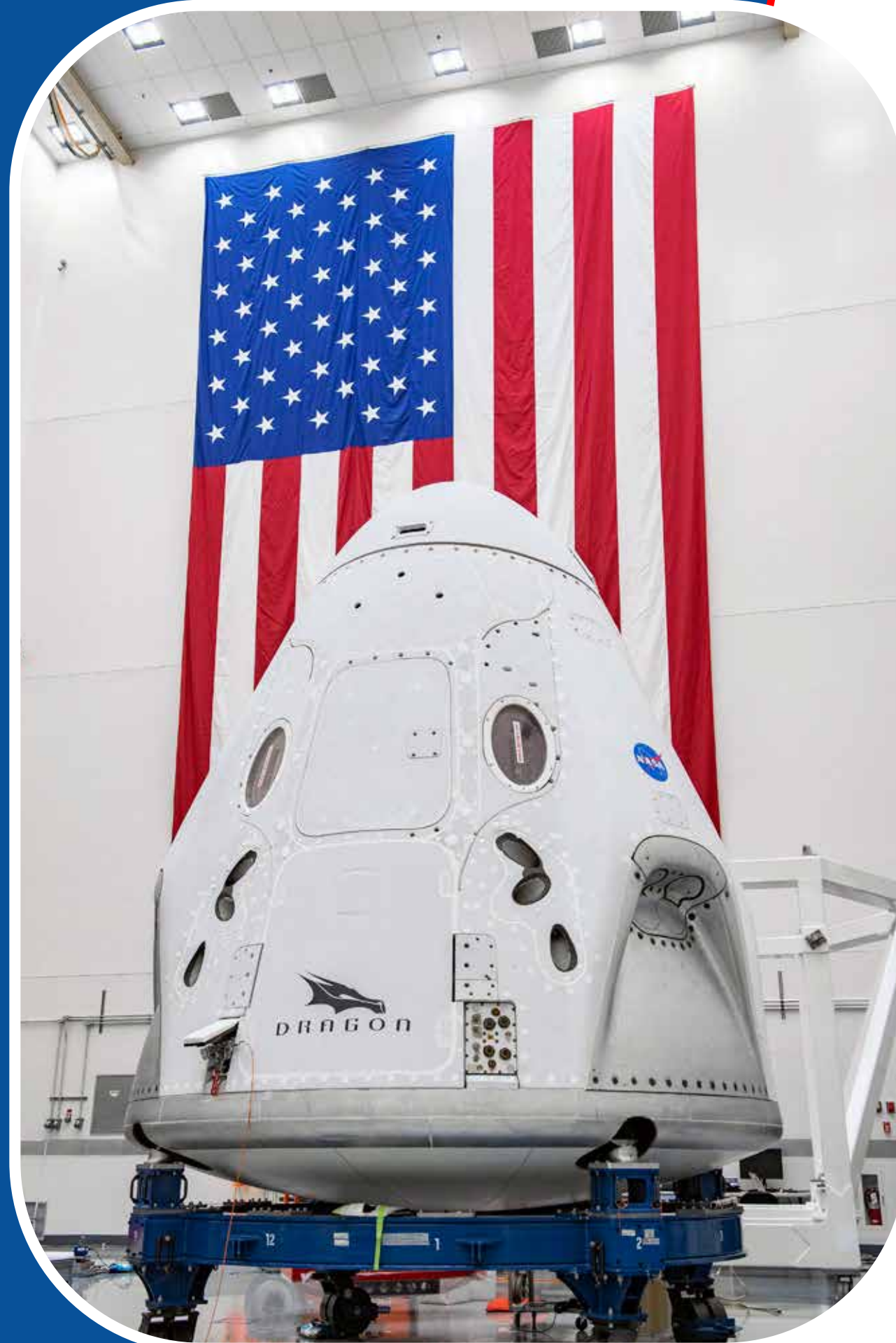
Invite Participants

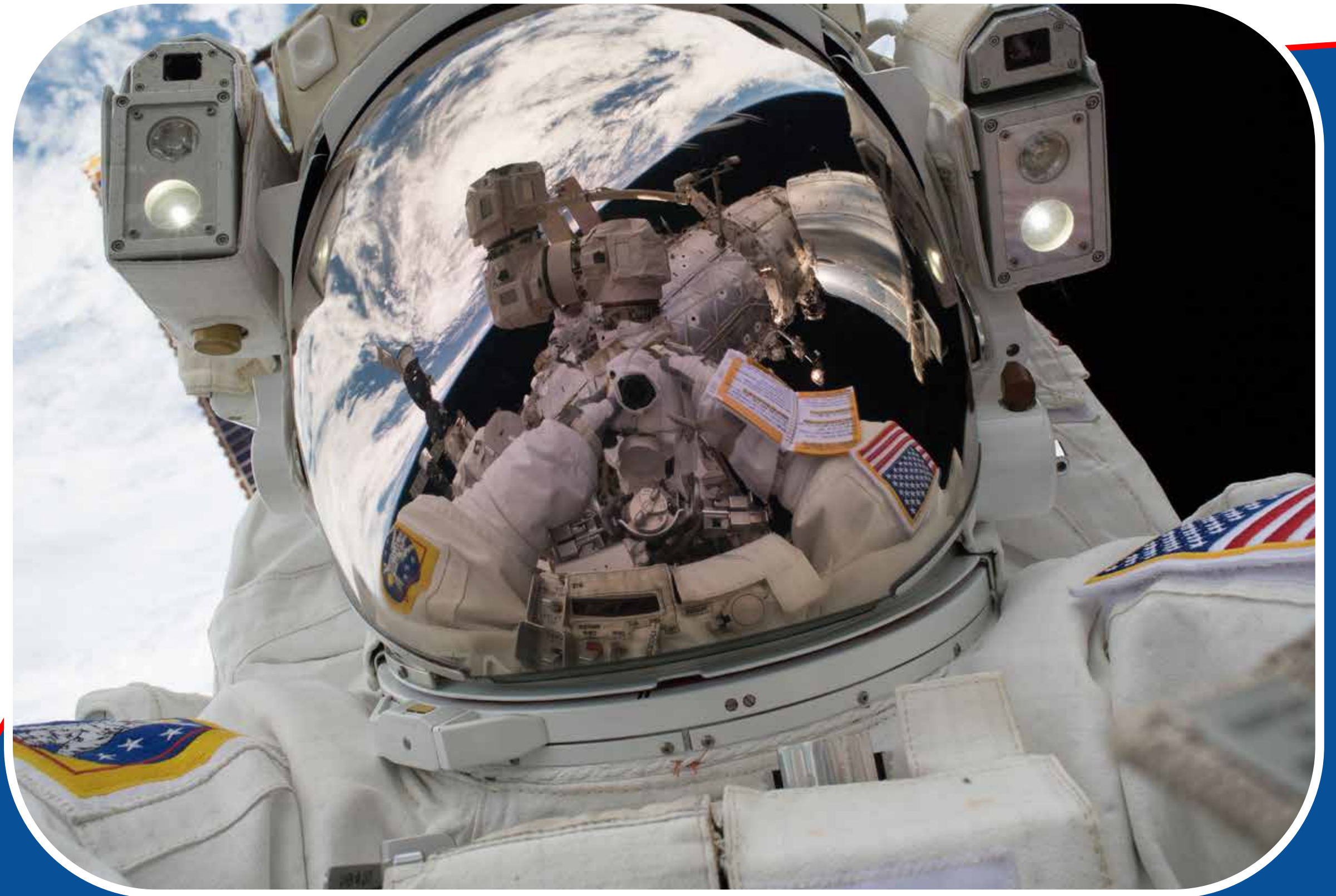
